**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODCREEK, TEXAS,
ADOPTING RAINWATER COLLECTION INCENTIVIZATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS the City Council has determined there are ongoing concerns regarding potentially serious water shortage problems from impacting the health, safety, and welfare of the Woodcreek community; and

WHEREAS the Texas Local Government Code, Section 580.004, authorizes and encourages municipalities to promote rainwater harvesting through incentives such as the provision at a discount of rain barrels or rebates for water storage facilities; and

WHEREAS the City Council finds the adoption of a Rainwater Collection Incentivization Program is in the public interest, and necessary for promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the Woodcreek community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODCREEK, THAT:

I.

The Woodcreek Rainwater Collection Incentivization Program is hereby approved and adopted for purposes of promoting water preservation efforts.

II.

The City Council directs City Staff to implement the “Woodcreek Rainwater Collection Incentivization Program,” to the extent reasonably possible and as funded through the City’s budget process for upcoming Fiscal Year 2025/2026 by establishing reasonable criteria as directed by the City Council, including but not limited to eligibility and application requirements.

III.

The City Secretary is instructed to include a copy of this Resolution among the records of the City.
