

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.1839 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of the City of Woodcreek.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.1839 per \$100
 NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$0.1817 per \$100
 VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.1861 per \$100

The no—new—revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2022 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City of Woodcreek from the same properties in both the 2021 tax year and the 2022 tax year.

The voter—approval rate is the highest tax rate that the City of Woodcreek may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no—new—revenue tax rate. This means that the City of Woodcreek is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 31, 2022 AT 2:00 PM AT Woodcreek City Hall — 41 Champions Circle, Woodcreek, TX 78676. A SECOND PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD ON September 14, 2022 AT 2:00 PM AT Woodcreek City Hall — 41 Champions Circle, Woodcreek, TX 78676.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter—approval tax rate. As a result, the City of Woodcreek is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the City Council of the City of Woodcreek at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by the City of Woodcreek last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by the City of Woodcreek this year:

Total tax levy on all properties	\$571,243	\$586,219	<i>increase of 14,976 or 2.62%</i>
