



Proclamation

September 17 – September 23, 2021 is Constitution Week

WHEREAS: It is the privilege and duty of the American people including the citizens of Woodcreek to commemorate the two hundred and thirty-fourth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America with appropriate ceremonies and activities; and

WHEREAS: Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week,

NOW, THEREFORE I, Gloria Whitehead, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Woodcreek in the County of Hays, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as

CONSTITUTION WEEK

and urge all citizens to study the Constitution and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the rights and responsibilities which that privilege involves.
